Shanon recommended that the Planning Commission appoint a committee, and the committee could do the legwork and can meet without publishing.

911 radio update – no new info

Police contract for 2018 – no contract has been received

DCED – new letter of intent to be given to Ed Fosnaught – Brian made motion to approve and resubmit the new letter of intent, Rob seconded. Motion carried.

George and Short Streets drainage repair-\$15,653 estimate from WM Aiken has been received. Krystal made motion to move forward with the repair, Brian seconded. Motion carried.

Adams Area Fire Protection Agreement – signed agreement March 1, 2018 for 5 year contract with 5 year extension.

530 residents starting at \$7.13/resident ending with 15.88/resident. Contract states that Mars Borough will bill for workman's comp.

Act 172 earned income tax – Brian noted that more municipalities are in favor of \$250 earned income credit for fire fighters. Valencia Boro is in agreement.

An approximate estimate for playground equipment was received to sandblast and powder coat –

\$100 – each basketball pole

\$400 – purple parts

\$800 – silver parts

\$750 – swings
