

MINUTES FROM VALENCIA BOROUGH COUNCIL

August 13, 2018 minutes from Valencia Borough Council.

ATTENDANCE: Pres. Brian Himmelstein, Rob Vigue, Mayor Krystal Schultz.

Minutes were read. Krystal made motion to accept minutes, Rob seconded. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report: Rob made motion to accept treasurer's report, Krystal seconded. Motion carried.

Paying bills: Krystal made motion to pay bills with exception of MS4 until clarification, Brian seconded. Motion carried.

VISITORS:

Old Business

MS4 water testing – Rob reported that the jars have arrived and samples need taken.

Several emails have been received regarding inter-municipal agreement.

Zoning – waiting for update from planning commission.

911 radio update – meeting 7/18. Krystal noted they are still waiting for a final cost and that the radio won't be available until possibly the end of the year. A meeting is scheduled for Oct. 17 at 3:00 pm.

DCED financial planning tabled.

Act 172 earned income tax credit for fire fighters – Adams Twp., Seven Fields and Callery are all in agreement. Krystal made motion to advertise Ord. 234, Rob seconded. Motion carried.

2017 audit – draft has been received. Rob made motion to approve the draft, Krystal seconded. Motion carried.
