ELECTIONS

Elections will be held at the Methodist Church Social Hall, Hays St. on Nov. 2, 2021. If you are registered to vote in Valencia Borough, you can vote between the hours of 7:00 am and 8:00 pm. Please come out and vote.

BUILDING PERMITS

Prior to any construction, reconstruction, alterations or relocation of any building or structure within the confines of the borough, a plot plan must be submitted to Valencia Borough. The plot plan must comply with the Borough’s Ordinance #100, with regards to building setbacks from property lines, other buildings and streets. The plot should also note utility, water and sewer lines. Before you dig you must contact Pennsylvania One Call System @ 1.800.242.1776 for location of any underground lines. Upon approval of your plot plan, Valencia Borough Council will file the information with Adams Township for the building permit.

IMPORTANT

Remember to keep your community clean! *Throw all refuse in appropriate containers for garbage removal. Please do not pour oil or hazardous materials into municipal sewer drains. Pick up any litter along our borough streets.*

No trashcans are to be left in the right of ways on borough streets after garbage pickup day.

IMPORTANT ROAD CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

Three Degree Road Turnback Project. For 2.5 years Valencia Borough, along with Adams Township, has been working with Penn DOT to take ownership of SR 3007 Three Degree Road. Phase 1 reconstruction, from the bridge at the borough park to Senate Court in Adams Township, has begun with tree trimming.

Shields Paving was awarded the contract and will begin replacing storm water piping in the coming weeks. We ask everyone traveling in the Borough to please be careful and have patience. For the most part Three Degree Road will be open to single lane traffic during worktimes. We expect to have heavy traffic on the other streets in the Borough as people try to avoid traffic delays.
