ELECTIONS

Elections will be held at the Valencia United Presbyterian Church on Sterrett St. on Nov. 7. 2017. If you are registered to vote in Valencia Borough, you can vote between the hours of 7:00 am and 8:00 pm. Please come out and vote.

BUILDING PERMITS

Prior to any construction, reconstruction, alterations or relocation of any building or structure within the confines of the borough, a plot plan must be submitted to Valencia Borough. The plot plan must comply with the Borough’s Ordinance #230, with regards to building setbacks from property lines, other buildings and streets. The plot should also note utility, water and sewer lines. Before you dig you must contact Pennsylvania One Call System @ 1.800.242.1776 for location of any underground lines. Upon approval of your plot plan, Valencia Borough Council will file the information with Adams Township for the building permit.
